SHORT COURSE IN 2021

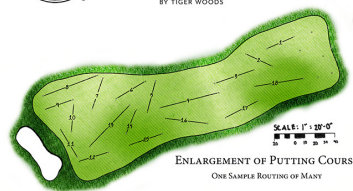
New Short Course 2021
